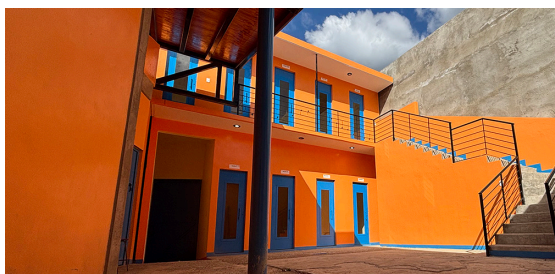


A triumphant start to the school year in Mexico

Twelve new music rooms

The Santa Cecilia music school in Oaxaca is growing rapidly. This year it welcomes 189 students, including 72 new ones. The opening of twelve new individual practice rooms comes at the perfect time to offer young people a dedicated space for studying their instrument alone or in small groups. They have good acoustics and are easy to use.

This is a major step forward, especially for students who live in cramped houses where practicing an instrument is difficult due to lack of space. Thanks to our partner La Banda de Musica and all the friends of Don du Choeur for this new setting which will allow many children to reveal themselves through music. ■

Switzerland

Private schools in Geneva, in agreement with AGEP, will be able to participate in 2026 in the **Dictée du Choeur**, a charity dictation competition to finance classrooms in Cambodia. A big thank you in advance to all those who will participate!

Cambodia

Over the next two years, all students at Ta Pen primary school will progressively benefit from **6 hours of instruction per day** instead of the current 4 hours. The need for new classrooms is enormous.

Madagascar

Goat farming, basket weaving, and beekeeping are finally established in Andohasatra. Support from Don du Choeur is resuming despite recent difficulties in Madagascar.

Cambodia: English as a priority

Since last April, on the recommendation of Don du Chœur, the TDSO institute has been training teachers in English throughout the Banteay Srei district. The level of English has already improved significantly in six months and our Ta Pen teachers are highly appreciated.

Soon, in our rural school, **English will be taught from the 3rd grade of primary school** through games, songs, individually or in teams, orally or on iPads. A mini revolution encouraged in Geneva by the International Institute of Lancy, which advises us and is donating 37 second-hand iPads this year. ■



Cambodia: Ta Pen becomes a pilot school

For its 16th school year, Ta Pen primary and secondary school received a certificate from the District Governor for the quality of Public Service rendered during the 2023-2024 school year.

Don du Chœur had organized a buffet at La Découverte school to celebrate their sporting achievement in collaboration with the Geneva Association of Cambodians. 86 student scholarships were funded by La Roue du Chœur in a magnificent spirit of solidarity.
