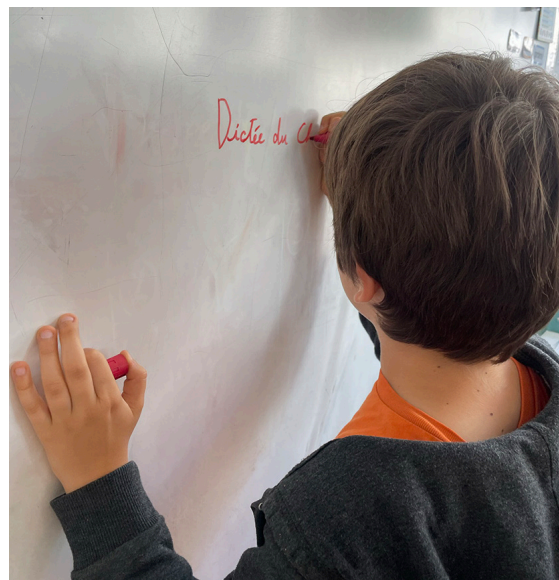

A Dictation Challenge with a Purpose

950 Geneva Pupils Taking Action...

Since the beginning of January, Geneva's private schools have brought dictation exercises back into the spotlight. Through an initiative by the Don du Choœur, pupils worked on the spelling of texts adapted to all levels. There were no bad grades to be had: only correctly spelled words were rewarded.

Around 950 pupils were able to showcase their spelling skills, give meaning to their efforts, and encourage families and friends to sponsor them. Their enthusiasm was so convincing that together they achieved an extraordinary feat: raising CHF 50'368 and funding three new classrooms, enabling 350 Cambodian children to finally attend Ta Pen Primary School full-time. The adventure continues as we work towards the construction of a new eight-classroom building... ■

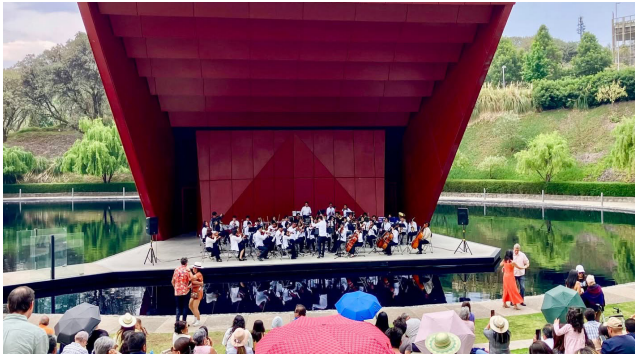
Switzerland: Partnership with Coop
